General Information

This peat inoculant is intended to be applied on-seed. It is a culture of a highly effective strain of rhizobia (nitrogen-fixing bacteria) that will colonize the plant roots to gather and fix the "free" nitrogen of the air, making it available to the plants.

Storage of Nature's Aid® Garden Seed Combination Humus:

Always read and follow instructions.

Store in a cool, dry place out of direct sunlight.

Store product between 40° and 77°F (4° and 25°C).

Open package only when ready to use.

Do not store in an area which is to be fumigated.

Small amount of product which cannot be used according to instructions may be disposed of in a landfill.

Directions For Use

The optimum method for applying Nature's Aid® Garden Seed Combination Humus is by using the slurry method.

Dampen the seed with non-chlorinated, clean, cool water at a rate of 8.5 oz (251.38ml) of water per 50 pounds (22.68kg) of seed.

Add appropriate amount of Nature's Aid® Garden Seed Combination Humus inoculant, 6 oz/50 lbs (170.1g/22.68kg) of seed. Mix water, seed and inoculant thoroughly until seed is uniformly coated.

This method should be done in a container outside of the planter box.

Allow 1 to 3 minutes for mixture to dry and then plant as soon as possible.

Nature's Aid® Garden Seed Combination Humus can also be applied dry directly onto the seed. Mix seed and inoculant thoroughly until seed is uniformly coated. Layering seed and inoculant will aide in this process.

Applying the inoculant dry is also recommended for seed that is pretreated with fungicide. However, maximum seed adhesion will not be obtained by applying this product dry.

This product is not solely recommended for first year ground or use on ground that is conducive to low rhizobia population due to environmental stresses and should be combined with other KALO products if used in that situation.

FOR SOILS THAT HAVE NEVER BEEN HOST TO THE LEGUME BEING PLANTED, APPLY AT A 1.5-2.0X RATE OR USE NATURE'S AID® GARDEN SEED COMBINATION HUMUS WITH A LIQUID INOCULANT PRODUCT FROM KALO, INC.
