First Aid

General Information

Concord is a unique adjuvant that delivers deposition enhancement and improved uptake, while providing an alternative to traditional nonionic surfactant, methylated seed oil, and crop oil concentrate adjuvants.

Concord provides equivalent or superior efficacy enhancement with improved crop safety.

Concord enhances absorption of water-soluble herbicides and is compatible with most pesticides and liquid fertilizers.

Cadence is approved for use with Regiment® Herbicide.

Environmental Hazards

Do not contaminate water sources by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastewaters.

Directions For Use

Obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood. For use with products registered for agricultural applications.

The addition of a spray adjuvant to some herbicides and/or fertilizers may cause phytotoxicity to the foliage and/or fruit of susceptible crops or non-targeted vegetation. Prior to the application of Concord to a spray mix, the user or applicator must have experience with the combination or must have conducted a phytotoxicity trial.

Use Rates

Ground: Use at 4 quarts per 100 gallons of spray mixture, or 1.0% by volume. This rate provides the spray adjuvant functions of both crop oil concentrates and surfactants.

Aerial: Minimum of 3 to 6 ounces per acre in 1 to 5 gallons of spray.

Mixing Instructions

Prior to any herbicide application, all spray mixing and application equipment must be clean.

Carefully observe all cleaning directions on the herbicide label.

Fill tank 1/3 to 1/2 full of water and begin agitation.

Slowly add the required amount of Concord and allow the product to completely disperse.

Continue filling spray tank with water and add herbicides and/or fertilizers as directed by label or in the following sequence: 1) Fertilizers and nutrients; 2) Dry flowables and dispersible granules; 3) Wettable powders; 4) Flowables; 5) Water-soluble herbicides; 6) Emulsifiable concentrates.

Storage, Disposal & Spill

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: STORE LOCKED UP. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep cool. Store in a tightly closed container. Store in original container only.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse or equivalent during mixing and loading and add rinsate to spray tank. Recycling decontaminated containers is best option for disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program. To contact your state and local ACRC recycler, visit www.agrecycling.org. Dispose of contents and container in accordance with local/national regulations.
